



With a 'Stage not Age' ethos, the nursery team supports each child's growth and development through the delivery of excellent education and care within a nurturing and enriching environment.


Unlike other nurseries in the area, we offer a range of activities to encourage learning, movement and well-being, including Yoga, cookery, language classes and forest schooling.

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Our Curriculum

At The Webber Nursery, we follow the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) Curriculum and ensure that each phase of learning is extended through wider experiences both inside and outside the classroom.

Our passionate and highly qualified Nursery team deliver educational excellence in a nurturing, vibrant and enriching environment, supporting each child's growth and development and ensuring all pupils are happy and well cared for.

We place great emphasis on health and wellbeing for all children in our care and from a young age, there is a focus on the importance of healthy minds and healthy bodies.

A continuous and seamless curriculum for our youngest children through to our preschool age pupils, ensures that we are providing the best possible start for each child, nurturing their individual talents, sparking their curiosity and igniting a lifelong love of learning.

Little Explorers Room (6 months to 2 years)

For the youngest children in our care, we focus on the Prime Areas of the EYFS curriculum - Personal, Social and Emotional Development, Physical Development and Communication and Language.

Little Adventurers Room (2 to 3 years)

The children play and learn under our expert guidance, during which time we observe, record and share their progress with you, via our online platform. Literacy and Mathematics are incorporated into continuous provision to ensure the children develop an awareness of letters, sounds and numbers.

Little Learners Room (3 years+)

Daily Literacy and Mathematics sessions help the children in Little Learners to develop the specific areas of the EYFS curriculum. The children also receive specialist teaching, allowing them to broaden their knowledge of languages, PE, digital learning, Music and Yoga. We support each child to develop their independence and problem-solving skills, building a solid foundation for their future and laying a seamless pathway for their learning journey into Reception class and beyond.

Admissions

We believe in a personal approach and keeping things simple. Our Nursery and Admissions team are on hand throughout the process to answer any questions that you may have. Admissions in five easy steps:

1. Register your interest to begin the process, contact our Admissions Registrar, Sandra Murchison on **01908 574740** or email **registrar@webberindependentschool.co.uk**
2. Book a tour Come and visit us at The Webber Nursery. You will meet our Nursery Manager and members of our Nursery team and have the opportunity to visit each of our dedicated rooms.
3. Register for a place with us at this stage, we require a £100 deposit and a completed application form.
4. Offer An offer of a place will be made in writing if we feel that we can provide the care that your son or daughter needs.
5. Acceptance On acceptance of a place and once payment of the deposit has been received, we will invite you and your child to a series of settling in sessions, so that you can familiarise yourselves with the Nursery setting and staff, and we can learn all about your child.
