#### We are delighted to share with you the new and extended Term 2 Extra Curricular Activities and Leadership Programme.

The programme is based on feedback from Student Councils and Student and Parent Surveys and includes some exciting new opportunities.

It offers a wide range of over 60 clubs, activities and opportunities across the Reception to Year 11 age range and we aim to offer something to interest everyone!

Student Leadership opportunities was one of the 6 Key Priorities for last academic year and the new ECA programme includes many opportunities for Seniors Students to support, coach, mentor and lead activities and working groups. This helps our young people to build up their digital portfolio of leadership experience and skills which gives them the 'Webber Edge' and helps them stand out in their Prefect, Head Student, Post 16 Sixth Form and College interviews. These opportunities give our students the chance to serve in their School and wider community and to give something back. These leadership opportunities also help our young people to develop as individuals to become confident, articulate and impactful young adult and contribute toward their Community Service Awards.

Digital sign-up for these Extra Curricular Activities will be running between **Thursday 4 January from 9am until Monday 8 January at 3pm** through Magic Booking. If you are a first time user of this system, I have put together a step-by-step guide to making bookings.

**Step 1** - please follow the link to magic booking <u>https://webberindependentschool.magicbooking.co.uk</u> or click <u>here</u>.

**Step 2** - (if you do not have an account) – click 'Forgot your password?' button, enter your email address to receive a link to reset your password.

Please note this must be the same email address that we hold on the School system, you will not be able to use any other email. If this needs updating, please contact the Admin Team on <a href="mailto:reception@webberindependentschool.co.uk">reception@webberindependentschool.co.uk</a>

**Step 3** - (if you do not have an account) – you will then receive a link to reset your password once this is done you will now have access to the system.

Step 4 – select the type of activity you would like to book.

Step 5 – follow the steps on screen and make sure to answer questions where appropriate.

**Step 6** – please ensure to make payment(s) at the time of booking where necessary to ensure your booking does not get cancelled by the system.

#### **Waiting List Check**

**Step 7** – Double check whether your child is on the Activity or the Waiting List by clicking the 'Bookings' tab at the top of the page.



**Step 8** – Scroll to the bottom, this will show you all the activities you have signed your child up for however, this **does not mean they are accepted.** The 'balance' column refers to any outstanding amount to pay so in the example below all money is 'cleared' meaning there is no money left to pay.
