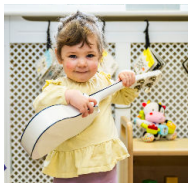

OUR ROOMS

Our Nursery is full of awe and wonder where teachable moments are captured and extended.

The Webber Nursery is divided into four stimulating rooms, allowing children to thrive in small groups with individual attention. The children also benefit from their outdoor exploration areas with an abundance of space for play and discovery.



Little Explorers (6 months to 1 year)

For the youngest children in our care, we focus on the Prime Areas of the EYFS curriculum - Personal, Social, and Emotional Development, Physical Development, and Communication and Language.



Little Adventurers (1 to 2 years)

The children play and learn under our expert guidance, during which time we observe, record, and share their progress with you, via our online platform. Literacy and Numeracy are incorporated into continuous provision to ensure our the children develop an awareness of letters, sounds, and numbers.



Little Learners (2 to 3 years)

As well as daily Numeracy and Literacy development the children also receive specialist teaching, allowing them to broaden their knowledge of Languages, Physical Education, Forest School/Ecological Learning, and Yoga.



Pre-Reception (3+)

We support each child to develop their independent problem-solving skills, building a solid foundation for their future whilst also laying a seamless pathway into Reception.



YOUR CHILD'S LEARNING JOURNEY

A love for learning starts from as early as six months with a 'Stage not Age' ethos, the Nursery Team supports each child's growth and development through the delivery of excellent education and care within an enriching and inspiring environment.

We offer a range of activities to encourage a natural learning movement throughout the school. We are a family with a culture of kindness that values learning from each other's experiences, backgrounds, and cultures.

With the children at the very centre of all that we do, our approach to Early Years Education is very much led by the children, their interests, and important life events. Our planning is 'In The Moment' specific to each child and relative to what is happening in the world around us.

We have created a delicious menu to encourage a healthy diet, and actively encourage our children to engage in the process of planning and cooking meals. Where possible, we use seasonal fruit, herbs, and vegetables that have been grown on-site and hand-picked by our children!
