Our Rooms

Little Explorers (6 months to 2 years)

Focusing on the key areas of the EYFS curriculum: Personal, Social, Emotional Development, Physical Development, Communication and Language.

Little Adventurers (2 to 3 years)

The children play and learn under our expert guidance, during which time we observe, record, and share their progress with you. Literacy and Numeracy are incorporated into our provision to ensure they develop an awareness of letters, sounds, and numbers.

Little Learners (3 years)

In addition to daily numeracy and literacy activities, children benefit from specialist teaching in Languages, Physical Education, Forest School, Ecological Learning, and Yoga.

Pre-Reception (3.5 years plus)

We nurture each child's independent problem-solving skills, creating a strong foundation for their future and a smooth transition into Reception. Our Reception transition programme spans 6–8 weeks, giving children the opportunity to fully explore and embrace what lies ahead.



Full Day: 7:30am - 6:00pm

Half Day: 7:30 am - 1:00 pm or 1:00 pm - 6:00 pm

We are open 51 weeks per year, excluding bank holidays and 3 team development days. Our Nursery will be closed for one week between Christmas and New Year.



Our fees include all meals, featuring home-cooked, nutritionally balanced options for breakfast, mid-morning snacks, lunch, afternoon snacks, and afternoon tea.

Fees

Our nursery fees are designed to offer exceptional value, covering a comprehensive range of services to support your child's development and well-being. Minimum 2 full days or 4 half day sessions

We issue invoices around 20th for the following month and ensure all payments are made before the 1st. We cannot issue refunds for sickness or holidays. Fees will be reviewed in accordance with Nursery operating costs, any increases will be announced month in advance.

Ad Hoc Sessions

Subject to availability, ad hoc days are available at our standard daily rate. We ask you request any ad hoc days between 2-10 working days before your preferred date.

Sibling Discount

Receive a 10% discount when your second child joins The Webber Nursery or Webber Independent School, and a 15% discount when your third child joins.

Funding

At The Webber Nursery, children can take advantage of government funding schemes. If eligible, your child will qualify for funding starting in the term after their qualifying birthday.

Our Nursery operates 51 weeks a year, so the government funding, which typically covers 38 weeks (term time), is distributed across the full year. This means 15 funded hours per week are stretched to 11 hours weekly and those eligible to 30 funded hours per week are stretched to 22 hours weekly to align with our year-round schedule.

If eligible for age specific funding please see our outline (*eligible the month after the relevant birthday*).

2 to 3 Years

Eligible children may receive 15 hours of funding per week, amounting to a total of 570 hours per year. At The Webber Nursery, this funding is available exclusively to full-time children attending Monday through Friday.

3 to 5 Years

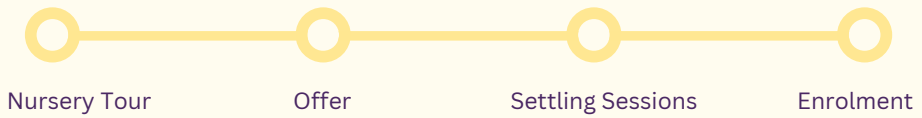
After their third birthday, all families in England are eligible for a total of 570 hours of funding per year, which can be used flexibly, subject to terms and conditions. Some families are eligible for a further 570 hours from April 2025, and this can be used on a plan of 3 days or more per week.

Admissions Process



Registration

To start the admissions process, simply complete an enquiry form, available on our website or through our Registrar. Our Admissions Registrar will then reach out to arrange an introductory call and a visit to the nursery.

Following your visit, and based on availability and your preferences, we will either offer your child a place or add them to our waiting list.

To secure your child's place, we invite you to register and pay a £100 refundable deposit. We kindly ask that you confirm acceptance within 48 hours to guarantee availability. The deposit will be deducted from your first month's invoice.

Withdrawal

If you wish to withdraw your child before the expected leaving date, we require one month's written notice, received by the last working day of the penultimate month. Otherwise, a month's fees will be charged. For Pre-Reception children, a notice period of four months is required prior to transitioning into Reception.

Settling Sessions

We provide complimentary settling-in sessions tailored to each child's needs, with varying durations and levels of parental involvement. These sessions begin one week before your chosen start date, and most children feel comfortable and confident after three sessions. After a review with you and your child, we'll transition to the full-day schedule starting the following week.

Requesting Session Changes

If you wish to change your plan, please submit a request to our Nursery Manager. As our plans and timetables are carefully structured, changes are not guaranteed unless an alternative plan is available for adjustment.

Tax Free Childcare

Tax-Free Childcare offers substantial monthly savings and is available for all Nursery-aged children. This scheme can also be combined with the funding options mentioned above.
