Senior School

Senior School is a time of growing responsibility, academic challenge and preparation for GCSE examinations. At The Webber Independent School, our small class sizes allow us to deliver personalised learning, enhancing the National Curriculum with additional subjects, clubs, enrichment trips, and workshops. We offer a modern, engaging and collaborative approach to private education.

With a diverse range of GCSE subjects and a strong track record in academic excellence, we provide flexibility to suit different abilities and talents. Some students take early entry GCSE Mathematics in Year 10, allowing them to study Further Mathematics or an additional GCSE in Year 11. Through psychometric assessments and one-on-one interviews, we guide students through the transition from Year 9 to Year 10, helping them select subjects aligned with their strengths.

Our proven approach delivers outstanding GCSE results, with nearly half of all exams achieving top grades (9-7). On average, students improve by almost a full grade per subject, with some exceeding expectations by two or more grades. From Year 7 to Year 11, we are committed to ensuring every student reaches their full potential.

In Little Webber, we follow the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) Curriculum, extending each phase of your child's learning through a range of experiences inside and outside the classroom. Prep School

Senior School

At Webber, we encourage students to ask, "What have you done today to make you feel proud?"-a question that embodies our positive learning environment and school song, Proud. We take great pride in our students' academic achievements, with 100% of Year 11 pupils achieving Grade 4 and above since 2019, many surpassing expectations through outstanding Value Added results. Our personalised approach, Study Skills Programme and enrichment activities provide the perfect foundation for success. As students transition from Year 9 to Year 10. we support their GCSE subject selection through Cambridge Online Assessments and one-on-one guidance, ensuring choices align with their strengths. Offering a diverse range of subjects, we cater to different abilities, with options for early entry in GCSE first language or Mathematics, leading to Further Mathematics in Year 11. This flexibility prepares students for A Levels and future academic success.

By Car:

from Milton Keynes Central, head south on Wolverton Road, then follow signs to the A421 and head southeast. Turn onto the A509 (Northfield Drive) and continue until you reach the school, which is located just off the road.

By Train:

We are located just 2.7 miles away from Milton Keynes Central Train Station. with just an 8 minute journey via car (£5-£10 taxi/Uber).

By Bus:

You can take the Arriva Bus Line 7, which operates between Milton Keynes Central and the school. The journey takes approximately 24 minutes and costs around £2.
