We are delighted to share with you the Extra Curricular Activities and Leadership Programme.

The programme is based on feedback from Student Councils and Student and Parent Surveys and includes some exciting new opportunities.

We offer a wide range of clubs, activities and opportunities across the Year 7 to Year 11 age range, and we aim to offer something to interest everyone!

Student Leadership opportunities are key to personal development and this ECA Programme includes many opportunities for Senior Students to support, coach, mentor and lead activities and working groups. This helps our young people to build up their Digital Portfolio of leadership experience and skills which gives them the 'Webber Edge' and helps them stand out in their Prefect, Head Student, Post 16 Sixth Form and College interviews. These opportunities give our students the chance to serve in their School and wider community and to give something back. These leadership opportunities also help our young people to develop as individuals to become confident, articulate and impactful young adults and contribute toward their Community Service Awards and Character Education.

Our Nursery and Prep School children really enjoy playing and learning alongside our older students who they look up to as role models and the older students gain as much from this interaction too! Working together across the Key Stages and phases of the School is what makes Webber a family school.

Once signed up, students must commit to regular attendance for 10 weeks and see the staff member in charge in advance if they are unable to attend for any reason.


