We are delighted to share with you the Extra Curricular Activities and Leadership Programme.

The programme is based on feedback from Student Councils and Student and Parent Surveys and includes some exciting new opportunities.

We offer a wide range of clubs, activities and opportunities across the Year 7 to Year 11 age range, and we aim to offer something to interest everyone!

Student Leadership opportunities are key to personal development and this ECA Programme includes many opportunities for Seniors Students to support, coach, mentor and lead activities and working groups. This helps our young people to build up their Digital Portfolio of leadership experience and skills which gives them the 'Webber Edge' and helps them stand out in their Prefect, Head Student, Post 16 Sixth Form and College interviews. These opportunities give our students the chance to serve in their School and wider community and to give something back. These leadership opportunities also help our young people to develop as individuals to become confident, articulate and impactful young adults and contribute toward their Community Service Awards and Character Education.

Our Nursery and Prep School children really enjoy playing and learning alongside our older students who they look up to as role models and the older students gain as much from this interaction too! Working together across the Key Stages and phases of the School is what makes Webber a family school.

Once signed up, students must commit to regular attendance for 10 weeks and see the staff member in charge in advance if they are unable to attend for any reason.

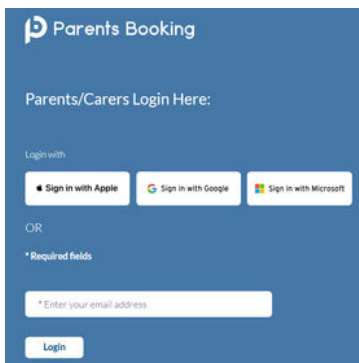

Booking your child's school club is quick and easy through the **Parents Booking Portal**.

1. **Log in** to the Parents Booking Portal.
2. Under the **Wraparound** header, you will find a list of all the clubs currently available to book.
3. **Select the club** you would like your child to attend.
4. Use the **calendar** to view the dates the club will run and select the sessions you would like to book.
5. Follow the booking process to confirm your child's place.

To ensure your child can attend their preferred ECAs, we recommend you book early, as capacity in each club may be limited. Please make sure to check if you are accepted or on a waiting list for the club.

The students will be expected to commit to the club for the whole term.

Clubs will commence **Wednesday 9 September 2026**.

If you are booking Extra Curricular Activities and require After School Provision after the Activity as you are not already paying for wrap around care on fee structure - Option 2, please ensure to book the appropriate After School Provision event using the same link as above. For our newer parents, Before and After School Provision is booked the same way as above. You only need to book Before and After Provision on Parents Booking if you Opted for Option 1 School Fees.
